

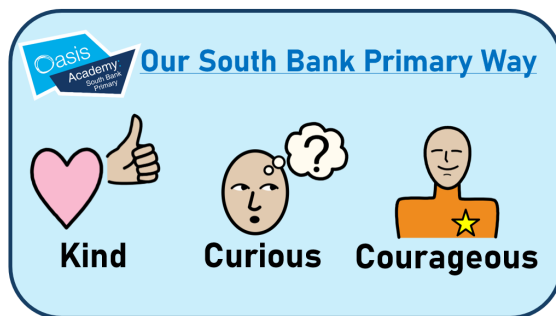


Oasis Academy South Bank Primary Newsletter

At the end of last half-term, our staff and I spent part of our Inset Day reviewing our Academy Way. Our three key words that we aspire to be are: **kind**, **curious** and **courageous**. This applies not just to our children, but to ourselves and our community.



We discussed how these qualities can apply to different areas of the school and what our behaviour expectations are around movement in school, listening and various classroom behaviours. In September, we will share an updated Academy Way document that details some of these. We also discussed our approach to praise and ways we could celebrate learning and behaviours in the new academic year. Results from the tests will be shared when your child's report is sent home on Friday, 11th July.

Finally, you will hopefully have seen the letter earlier this week inviting you to our Sports Day on Thursday, 26th June at Archbishop's Park. This is for children in Key Stage 1 and 2. We will be holding a separate event for children in EYFS classes and will send out a letter to those families soon with detail.
