Dear South Bank Primary Family,

As you'll be aware we have been experiencing challenges with our heating system over the last fortnight. The Oasis Premises and Estates Team are in the process of implementing a long-term solution. In the meantime, we have made sure all classrooms have electric heaters and temperatures are being monitored throughout the day to make sure children and adults are learning in a warm and comfortable environment. I will share further updates as soon as we have full confirmation of the next steps.

You may notice after half-term that our Gold class is moving into the classroom next to Red class for the remainder of the year. This will give the children lots of benefits including a larger learning space, outdoor area and mean they are closer to the rest of the school. The team are looking forward to the new opportunities this will bring.

As we head into the second half of the academic year, a lot of our focus is on statutory assessments, especially for year 6. We are incredibly proud of how they performed in their recent mock SATs. Their average maths score placed them 2<sup>nd</sup> out of all Oasis Academies nationally – an amazing achievement and a real credit to their hard work!

Whatever your child's year group, it's important we balance the pressure of any assessments with their wellbeing and social and emotional development. I hope over half-term you are all able to enjoy some quality time and experiences together.

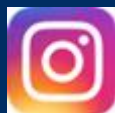
