Packed lunches

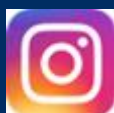
A reminder that if you decide to change your child's lunch from a school dinner to packed lunch, please let the school office know. This lets us inform the kitchen staff and avoids food waste.

The drop-in takes place every Tuesday during term time from 9:00 am–12:00 pm.


There's no need to book, just pop in when it suits you. Whether you'd like support with CVs, job applications, accessing services, or you just want some time to talk things through, I'm here to help.
