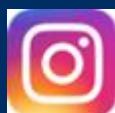
Harvest assembly

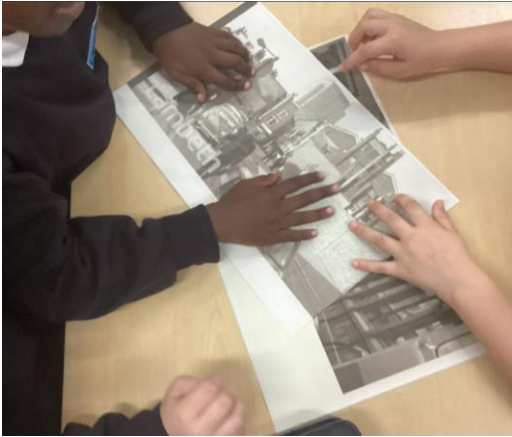
Learning this week

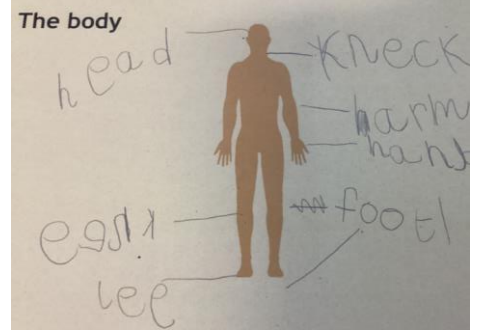
