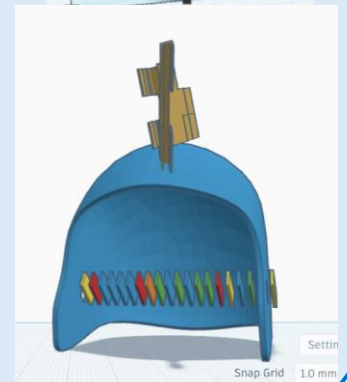
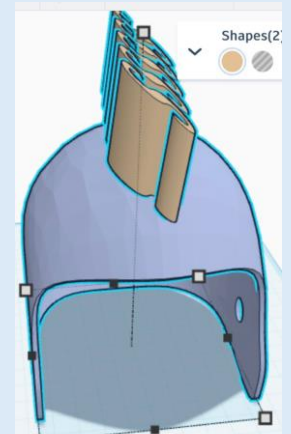
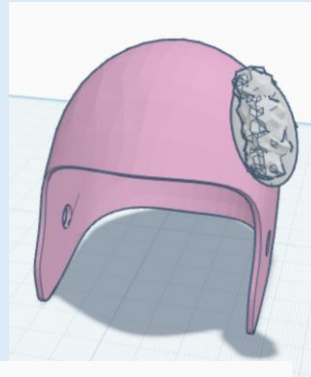
Big improvements in attendance over the last two weeks and especial well done to year 3 who have improved by 5%! Let's see if we can get all classes up to 95%+

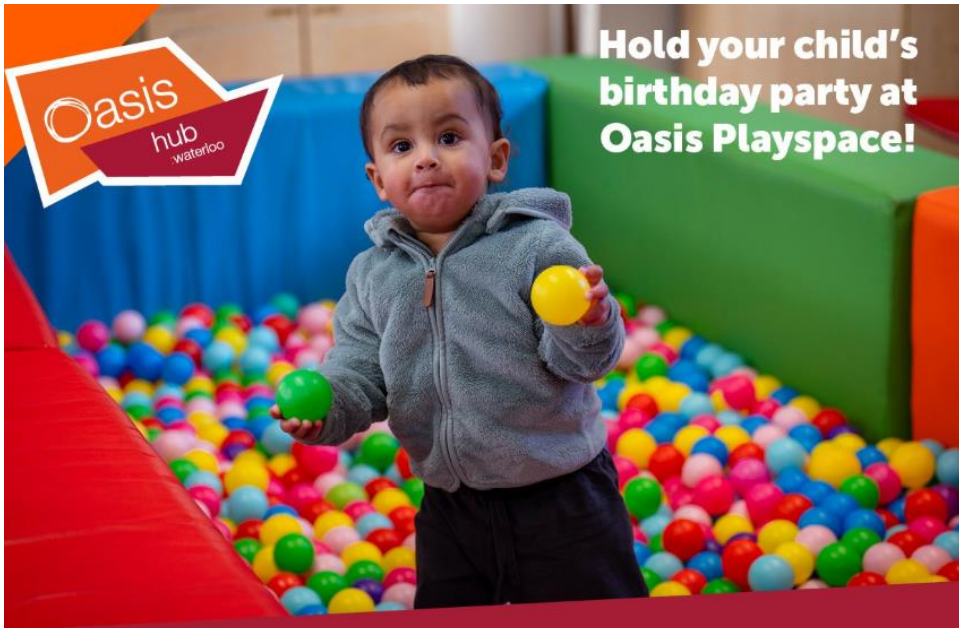
