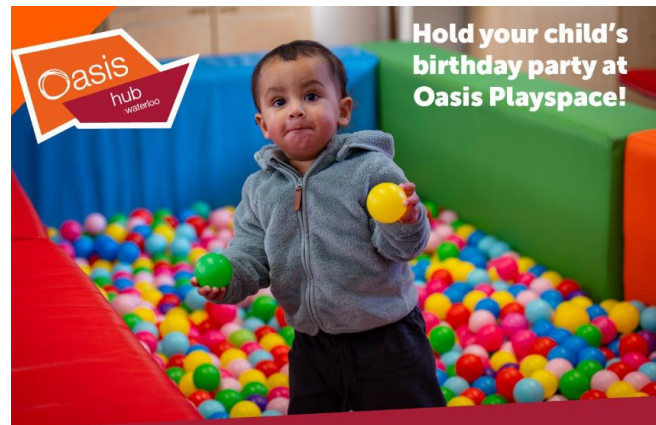


Attendance

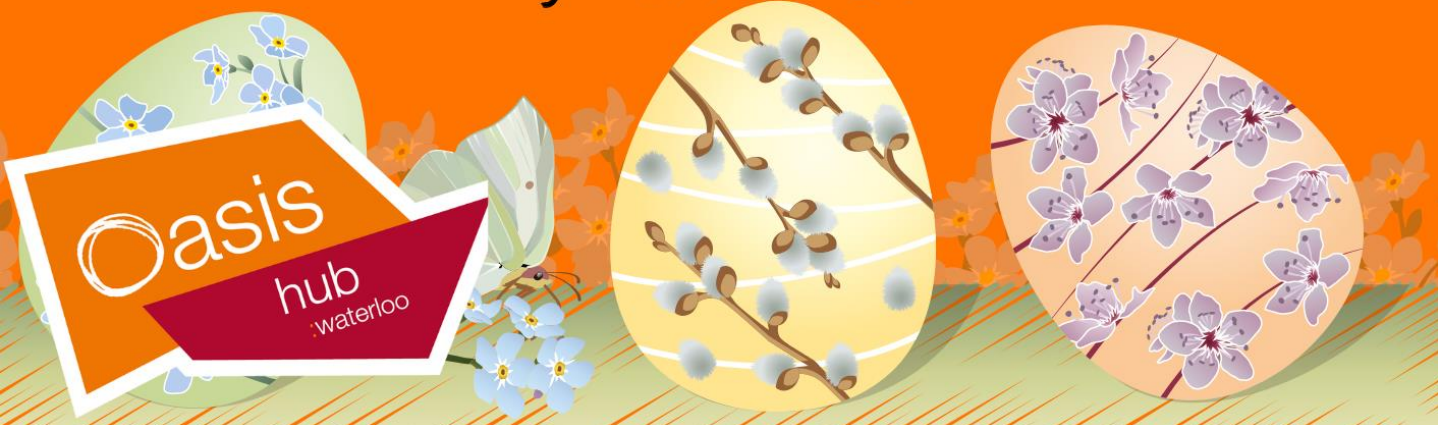
